## Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA Rocailles (R10)
3319 001; 10/o; 49102; 5 g
PRECIOSA Rocailles (R9)
3319 001; 9/0; 68301;2g
PRECIOSA Pip ${ }^{\text {TM }}(\mathbf{P})$
$11101346 ; 5 \times 7 \mathrm{~mm}$;
23980/29123; 67x

0.20 mm a nylon line; a long thin needle; scissors; a carabiner, rings, flat nose pliers (for flattening the beginning of the line, closing the rings)


Difficulty:
Techniques: netting

## Procedure:

Step 1:
Affix the rocaille in the middle of about 300 cm of line by passing the line through the rocaille twice. This rocaille will function as astop bead and it will be removed later.


Step 2:
String $1 \times$ R9, $2 \times$ R10, $1 x$ R9, $2 \times$ R10, $1 x$ R9 and $2 \times$ R10 and move them to the stop bead and thread the line through the first R9.


Step 3:
String $2 \times$ R10, $1 \times$ R9 and $2 \times$ R10 and thread the line through the third $\mathbf{R} 9$ from step 2.


Step 4:
String $2 x$ R10, 1x R9, 2x R10, $1 \times \mathbf{P}, 1 \times$ R9 $1 \times \mathbf{P}, 1 \times \mathbf{R} 9$ and $1 \times \mathbf{P}$ and thread the line back through the R9, additionally string 2x R10, 1x R9 and 2x R10 and thread the line through the $\mathbf{R} 9$ from step 3.


Step 5:
String $2 \times$ R10, 1 x R9 and 2 x R10 and thread the line through the R9.


Step 6:
Repeat step 5 seven times.


Step 7:
Repeat steps 3-6 until the necklace reaches the required length.


Step 8:
Repeat step 5 twice at the end.


Step 9
Sewing up the necklace
The stitch ends in the R10. String R9 and sew through 2x R10. Repeat till the end of the row. Continue in the sewing.
The stitch ends in the R10. Sew through the second half of the necklace according to the illustration.


Step 10:
Attach the fastening. Sew in and cut off the remainder of the line. The necklace is finished.
