

Easter magnets

Welcome in the spring with some fun creative work. You and your children can brighten up the Easter days and prepare your fridge for the incoming goodies by decorating it with permanently flecked eggs made from magnetic film, colored paper and the essential microbeads.

Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA BMX 40 microbeads

632 651 9 400 080 lemon yellow

632 651 9 400 010 orange

632 651 9 400 095 pink

632 651 9 400 021 purple

632 651 9 400 032 blue

632 651 9 400 050 green

632 651 9 400 140 gold

- self-adhesive magnetic film (the thinner variants are the best); A4 colored paper; A4 white paper; scissors; decorative hole-punches; double-sided white tape; a pencil for tracing the template (a regular pencil, a felt tip for smooth surfaces)



Difficulty:


Technique: gluing, cutting

Procedure:

Step 1:

Create the template for tracing.
Trace around it onto the white paper and cut out the shape of the egg (a hen's egg - 5.5 cm x 4 cm).





Step 2: Place the shape of the egg on the colored paper and trace around it.



Step 3: Cut the shape out of the colored paper.




Step 4: Place the shape into the hole-punch and punch some holes. Repeat the process several times, moving the shape at your own discretion.







You can select various degrees of layering on the magnetic foil according to the opacity and distinctiveness of the colors – a color scheme consisting of four basic colors.



(magnetic film - a sparkly hint of color from the microbeads)

Step 5:

Glue the hole-punched colorful egg onto the magnetic film.



Step 6: Cut the film around the edge of the egg.



Step 7: Sprinkle it with microbeads.







B - gluing the cut-out egg

(magnetic film, sticky tape - more intense shades of microbeads)

Step 8:


Remove the protective layer and glue on the double-sided tape.







Step 9: Adhere hole-punched, colorful egg onto it.



Step 10: Cut the film and the tape around the edge.



Step 11: Sprinkle it with microbeads.





C - gluing the cut-out egg (magnetic film, white paper, sticky tape clean shades of microbeads)

Step 12: Glue some white paper onto the magnetic





Step 13: Apply the double-sided tape.





Step 14: Adhere the hole-punched, colorful egg.



Step 15: Cut the film, paper and tape around the edge of the egg.




Step 16: Sprinkle on the microbeads.





Step 18: Select the method of layering. Adhere the layers and cut around the edge of the egg.




Step 19: Glue on the cut-out shapes.





Step 20: Sprinkle it with microbeads.



Step 17: First cut the egg from the magnetic film.
