Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA Candy Oval (C) 111 o1 388; 4 x 6 mm; 23980/15726 metallic coffee; 4x per pair;




PRECIOSA Rocailles (**R8**) 331 19 001; 8/0; 22m16 menthol matt; 50x per pair;



PRECIOSA Rocailles (RT) (R10) 331 19 001; 10/0; 22m18 green matt; 230x per pair (5 g for easier stringing)



PRECIOSA Rocailles (RP) (R10) 331 19 001; 10/0; 22m10 pink matt; 100x per pair (5 g for easier stringing)



PRECIOSA Rocailles (RC) (R10) 331 19 001; 10/0; 49095 metallic coffee; 100x per pair (5 g for easier stringing) - eye pins: 50 mm - 10x, 40 mm - 10x, 30 mm - 4x, 22 mm - 4x: longer eye pins are best, as they can be shortened; 4mm rings - 6x; earring hooks



- a thin needle; scissors; thin S-lon or Nymo nylon thread; pliers with rounded, pointy ends; snipping pliers; flat-nosed pliers



Difficulty:

Technique: eye pin linking, sewing, stringing

Procedure:

The earring frame

It consists of five rows of **C**, which interlock (zig-zag).

The 1st row = 5x, the 2nd row = 4x, the 3rd row = 3x, the 4th row = 2x and the 5th row = 1x.

Keep an eye on the front and back of the **C** when working.

Step 1

String 1x C in the upper hole and another 1x C in the lower hole onto a 40 mm eye pin. Alternate the stringing of the holes on the C until you have strung 5x in the 1st row and 4x in the 2nd row. Add the other C in the next rows placed on a mat. Pass the pin through the outer hole of the C at the beginning of the row. Insert a C into the gap and thread the eye pin all the way to the next empty hole in a C from the previous row. Continue in this way until you have completed all the rows. You can gradually use shorter eye pins, but keep in mind the need to create an eye at the end.







Start creating the second eye on the eye pins. Twist them in the same direction as the initial eye. The protruding piece of wire should be 7 - 8 mm long. This length will enable you to twist an eye that is the same size as the initial one. Grasp the end of the wire between the ends of the pliers. Twist the wire around the point. Gently tug on the pliers around the edge of the hole of the C so that the eye is centrally aligned above the hole. Do the same on all four rows.



Step 3
Complete the outer lower row at the empty hole in the C from the 1st row. Use a 50 mm eye pin. String 1x R8 onto the eye pin, pass it through the empty holes and add 1x R8 between them. String 1x R8 after the last C.

Also add an eye pin into the empty hole of the C in the 5^{th} row.



The tassels

String fifteen tassels. The longest is the central one, while the seven tassels in several R10 colours on either side of it gradually get shorter. The outer tassel 6.25 cm (RG); 6.5 cm (RG); 6.75 (RG); 7 cm (RP); 7.25 cm (RP); 7.5 cm (RO); 7.75 cm (RO); 7.75 cm (RC); 7.5 cm (RC); 7.5 cm (RT); 7 cm (RT); 6.5 cm (RT); 6.5 cm (RT); 6.25 cm (RT).

Step 4
Prepare 3 m of thread. thread it through
the eye of the needle and secure it with
a simple knot. Tighten it occasionally.
The thread is slippery and it will remain
strung for a long time when prepared
in this way.





Step 5
String 1x R8 and 8 cm of RO.
Move the stringing to the centre of the line.
Leave out the last strung RO.
Thread the line back through all the other
RO. Thread the line through the R8
from the opposite side.







Step 6
Pass the line through the strung **RO** under the **R8** one more time. String 1x **RO** and 1x **R8**. Thread the line through the **RO** from above.





Step 7
String 7.75 cm of **RO**. Include the **RO** under the **R8** from the 6th row. Leave out the last **RO** and pass the thread back through the others. Pass the line through the **R8** from the opposite side.






Step 8 Like Step 6.





Step 9
Repeat Steps 6 and 7. Choose the color and length of the **R10** stringing based on the order of the tassel that you are currently working on. When you get to the outer tassel, pass the line under the **R8** and 3x **R10**.





Step 10 Create the second half of the tassels.












Step 15 Connect three rings onto the eyes at the top of the frame. Add an earring hook to the centre ring.



Step 16



Connecting the frame and the tassels

Thread a 50 mm eye pin through the eyes on the right-hand side of the frame from above. Do the same with another 50 mm eye pin on the left-hand side. Twist the eye pins after the outer lower row. The top eyes of the eye pins should lie flat.



Create the second earring. Try to make its colors a mirror image of the first.





String 1x **R8**, the eye on the pin with the tassels and 1x R8 onto the bent part of the eye pins.

Create an eye on the protruding part of the wire. Do the same on the bent part of the other eye pin.
