Together they form a perfectly symmetrical whole. Get inspired by the range of colors and surface finishes and tune your accessories to perfection. You can also create another rosette in addition, hang it on a chain and add to earrings also the necklace.

2x earrings; Fireline 0,12 mm; needle; scissors


Dififulty: I/III
Technique: basic beadweaving

## Procedure:

Step 1:
Cut off approx. 30 cm of Fireline and threat into needle. Pick up 1x Ch through the first hole from the outside, $1 \times$ R9 and 1x Ch through the first hole from inside four times.
$\diamond$ $\square$ from inside

Step 3:
Pass through the second hole oh the $\mathbf{C h}$. ${ }^{*}$ Pick up 1x T and pass through the second hole of the next Ch. Pick up 1x R13, 1x P 1x R13 and pass through the second hole of the next Ch.*

Repeat from * to * until the round is finished.


Step 4:
Pass through the second hole of the $\mathbf{T}$, pick up 2x R13, 1x earring and 2x R13 and pass through the second hole of the $\mathbf{T}$. To stabilize the connection repeat thread way several times. Sew up thread and cut off.
