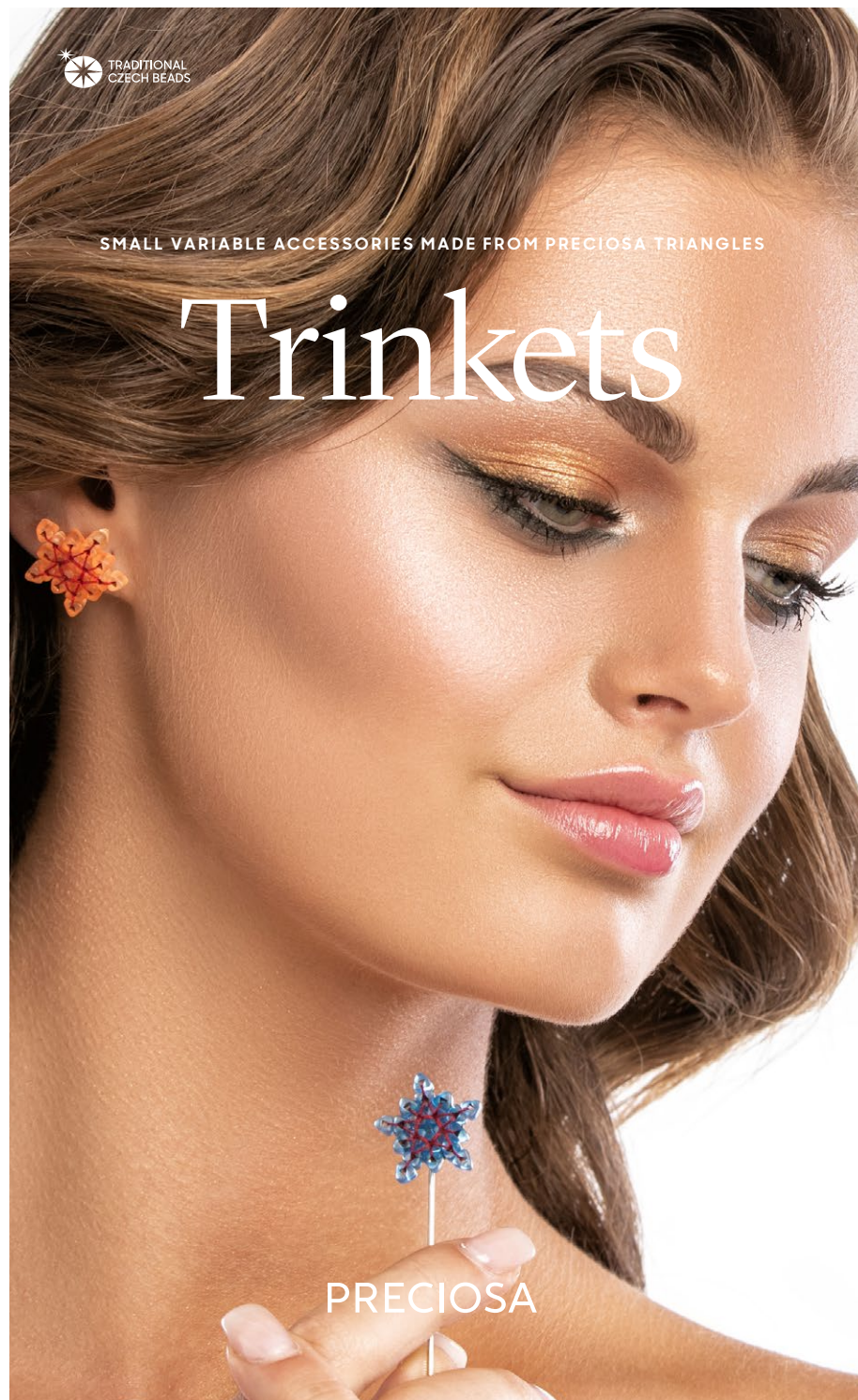

We are pleased to be able to introduce a new project made using PRECIOSA Triangles. You can choose seed beads from a large pallet of colors, as well as with linings and surface finishes. This delicate sewn pattern can be used in several ways, for example as a lapel decoration on a jacket, in earrings, as a ring or as an accessory on a hair clip.

Materials and tools:

321 41 001; 3,5 x 3,5 mm; 1 star = 20x

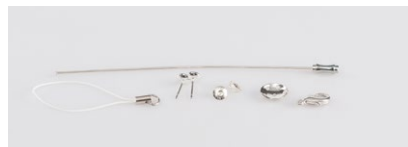

PRECIOSA Rocailles (R) - any arbitrary choice

- earrings - butterfly backs with a flat base, stops on the studs; a brooch - a pin, a small circle with a central opening (for example, a cup or a sieve); a pendant - a cord, end pieces with an eye, a ring and a carabiner



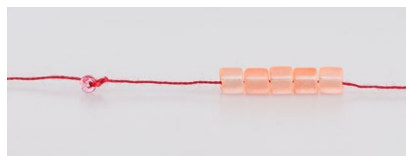
- a thin needle; a thin polyester or nylon line (for example, Belfil-S 50, Nymo); scissors; glue for non-absorbent surfaces (for example, a two-component epoxy glue)



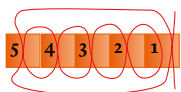
Difficulty: ▲▲▲▲▲

Procedure:

Step 1:
Cut off about 70 cm of line. Tie an R at the end. This will secure the T against slipping. String 5x T.



Step 2:
Sew the basic circle. Use the „square“ stitch and connect all 5 T one after the other. Connect the 1st and 5th T.



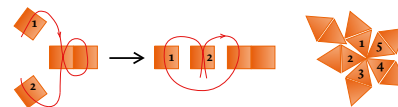
Step 3:
Thread the line through the 2nd T. String 1 new T. Return to the 2nd T.



Step 4:
Thread the line through the following T from the basic circle and always add 1x T to it.



Step 5:
String 2x T. Join them together. Thread the line from the basic circle through the 2nd T. Return to the lower T from the projection, then to the 1st T from the basic circle. Once again thread the line through the 2nd T. Place the back of the lower T from the projection so that it is located between the T from the basic circle.



Step 6:
Sew more projections consisting of 2x T into the other four gaps. When viewed from above, the basic circle is sewed through 2x and the projections are sewn through 1x.



Step 7:
Thread the line through the next T from the basic circle, so that both ends of the line are on the same side. Tie off the line with two knots. Place them close to the holes of the T. Pull both ends of the line into the hole. Pull on the ends so that the knots disappear. Cut off the line.



Step 8:
You can use these stars any way you want. For earrings, sew two of them and glue the flat base of the butterfly back onto them. Thread a cord through a hole in a T for a pendant and glue on the end pieces. Attach the carabiner using a ring. When assembling a brooch, bend the blunt end of the pin. Thread it through the central hole in the circle and glue it to the star.
